The foolish wisdom of the Three Wise Men

Their journey of encounter is an example for all of us

“I call them the three fools.”

“What?” I said a little incredulously to Dr. Robbins.

“Yeah, I call them the three fools. After all, who would leave everything that is safe and comfortable to travel in the darkness after a star merely because it promised something better?”

I knew what Dr. Robbins was doing. He was being provocative in a desire to teach me a lesson. We were standing in his office in front of a large painting depicting the Three Wise Men sitting on camels as they traveled by night to a distant star. That conversation was a seminal moment in how I came to understand the journey of the Three Wise Men.

God had revealed to the Three Wise Men, through a star rising in the East, that the King of the Jews was to be born. They traveled to Bethlehem, where the chief priests and scribes said he was to be born, so that they could worship Him. What an adventure that must have been! Did they ever doubt and consider turning back? Did they ever wonder if finding the King of the Jews would be worth it?

The Three Wise Men remind us that a life of faith — of following Jesus — is to be an adventure. God has created us for greatness. Jesus came that we would have life “to the full” (Jn 10:10) and that from His fullness “we have received grace upon grace” (John 1:16). So, why don’t we always experience that?

Think of the Israelites in the Old Testament. They complained against Moses about leading them into the discomfort of the desert. At times they thought it would be better to be

back in Egypt, a place in which they were enslaved! Why would they possibly want to go back? Although it was degrading, it was known, and in that sense, it was comfortable.

The same dynamic can occur in our own lives. We may have wounds we are not dealing with, settling with mediocrity in some area of our lives, or find ourselves constantly returning to an old pattern of sin. Why don’t we change? Well, one reason is that despite the fact we may not like where we are at, it is known — and therefore comfortable to us.

But the life of faith is not to be a life of comfort, but greatness. After their encounter with Jesus, the Scriptures say that the Three Wise Men, “departed to their own country by another way” (Mt 2:12). You see, when you have an encounter with Jesus, you are never the same way again. Jesus promises us that He constantly draws us closer to Him and that He “makes all things new” (Rev. 21:5). This Advent, Jesus desires to make you new through His love.

So, how is Jesus calling you this Advent and Christmas season to be uncomfortable for Him? How is He inviting you into a new place of healing, of peace, of joy, of life, of goodness by leaving what is known and comfortable to follow Him boldly? It may not make your life easier, but it will make it better.

The Three Wise Men remind us that we were made for greatness. Our lives are to be an adventure — to boldly embrace God’s will for our lives — to seek what is true, good and beautiful by leaving what is mediocre, safe and boring.

To live life comfortably for yourself?

Now that would be foolish.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register? All Catholics living in the Parish area and regularly participating in the liturgy are invited to register in the Parish. **Church attendance alone does NOT make you and your family registered members.** Registration is *required* for Baptism, First Communion, First Reconciliation, Confirmation, Marriage and Catholic Education programs.

Adults 18 and over need to be registered separately from their parents in order to get married, have their own children baptized, or be Godparents or Sponsors.

In order to be a **Godparent or Sponsor or to receive discounted tuition rates at Catholic Schools**, one must be a registered Catholic and active in the parish, which is indicated by use of contribution envelopes or the Online Giving program. Registration forms can be filled out in the Parish Office or via our parish website.

How do I have my child Baptized? Before scheduling the date, please call the Office for a welcoming conversation with the priest. A preparation class is also required for parents prior to the child's Baptism and are offered once a month.

How do I request a Communion Call or Anointing of the Sick? Please call the parish office at 480-893-8770. **DO NOT WAIT until someone is near death to have the person anointed!** Although Anointing of the Sick was once known as "Last Rites," waiting until a person is near death could risk that person not being able to receive the Sacrament if he or she should pass away prior to the priest being able to arrive. Anointing of the Sick can only be administered while the person is still alive.

How do I get married in the Church? The Diocese of Phoenix requires a **NINE MONTH** marriage preparation process. John Deg, Director of Married Life Ministries, will meet with you to explain the process, including when you will meet with the Pastor to set a date. **Do NOT set the date** prior to this meeting as it cannot be guaranteed until then.

News from Around the Diocese

Diocese of Phoenix Catholic Schools Office

For parents registering their children for the 2018-2019 school year, please note: In order to receive the school's reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your pastor must determine whether your family meets the criteria set by your parish for *Registered, Active, Participating members*. The definition of registered, active, and participating varies by parish, but usually includes attending Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to the offertory along with supporting the ministry life of the parish. If you have questions about your family's status, please contact your pastor directly. (Note: All Diocesan high school students receiving the reduced tuition rate for the coming year must have their status verified by their home pastor before they can be registered as Catholic.)





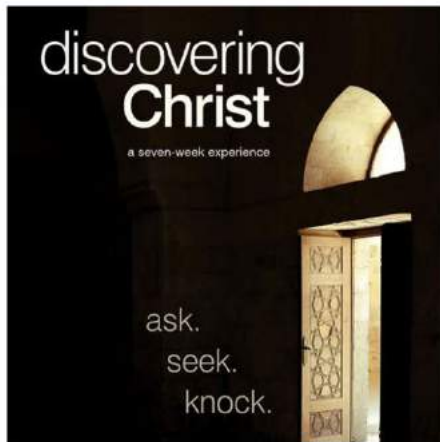
