Leader: O Lord, as we rejoice in the glory of Your Resurrection, place in our hearts a deep appreciation for the price of our redemption. You died on the Cross, and Your Heart was pierced so that Your Love and Mercy may be poured out for all eternity!

Accept this humble prayer of thanksgiving for all the blessings You give us each day. First, for the gift of Your own Mother, who became our Mother too. She, who is venerated here under so many of her titles, inspires her children to respond generously to the various needs of our parish family. We entrust to her all our affairs, knowing that she brings them to Your attention.

Today, we explicitly ask that Your Love and Mercy be poured out upon those who do not know You, and upon those who, though once faithful, have left Your Holy Church. May they be reunited with You—and with us—at the table of salvation, soon and forever.

We also pray that You lift up our Holy Father ..., our Bishop ..., our Pastor ..., and all bishops, pastors, priests, and clergy, as they faithfully give of themselves for the care of Your Body and Bride, the Church. Draw close to Your Heart all persecuted Christians and all innocent victims of sin and oppression.

Chaplet of Divine Mercy

All: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

All (3x):

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in You.

Leader: Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

All: Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Leader: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

All: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Leader: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell; on the third day, He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there, He will come to judge the living and the dead.

All: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

All: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.

All (3x): Pray for us.

Chaplet of the Holy Wounds of Our Lord Jesus Christ

*Given by our Lord to
Sr. Mary Martha Chambon*

This chaplet is prayed using an ordinary rosary.

On the crucifix, make the Sign of the Cross.

On the first Our Father bead, pray:
O Jesus, Divine Redeemer, be merciful to us and to the whole world. Amen.

On the three Hail Mary beads:

First bead – Strong God, Holy God, immortal God, have mercy on us and on the whole world. Amen.

Second bead – Grace and mercy, O my Jesus during these present dangers; cover us with Thy Precious Blood. Amen.

Third bead – Eternal Father, grant us mercy through the Blood of Jesus Christ, Thine only Son; grant us mercy, we beseech Thee. Amen.

On the Our Father bead:
Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Wounds of Our Lord Jesus Christ to heal the wounds of our souls.

On the sets of ten beads pray:
My Jesus, pardon and mercy through the merits of Thy Holy Wounds.

After 5 decades, conclude with (3x):
Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Wounds of Our Lord Jesus Christ to heal the wounds of our souls.
