

## Choosing a Confirmation Name

In the Bible, conversion to following God is often symbolized by a change in name: Abram becomes Abraham, Simon becomes Peter, Saul becomes Paul. At Baptism we receive a name to symbolize our new life in Christ. At Confirmation, you take a new symbolic name, that of a saint that you want to model your life after and who will be a reminder, for the rest of your life, of your Confirmation. If you would like, you can choose to keep your own Baptismal name at Confirmation after doing research on the saint for whom your parents named you.

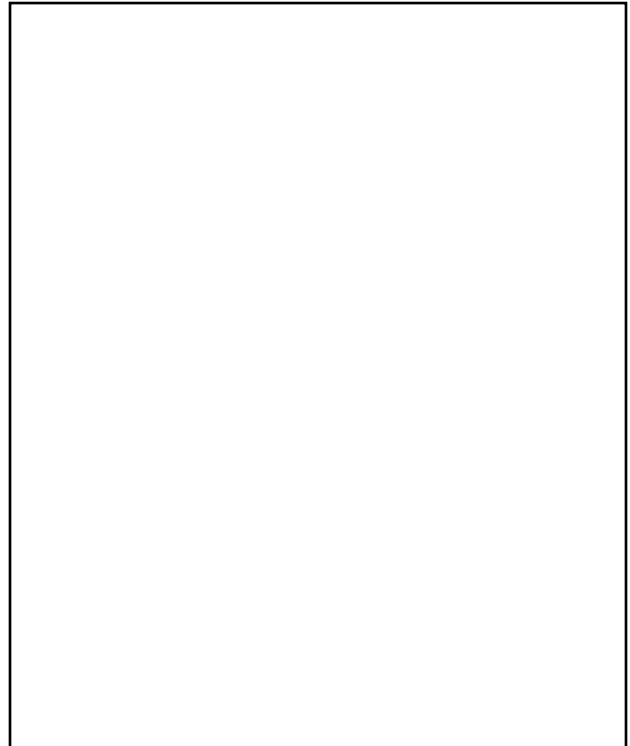
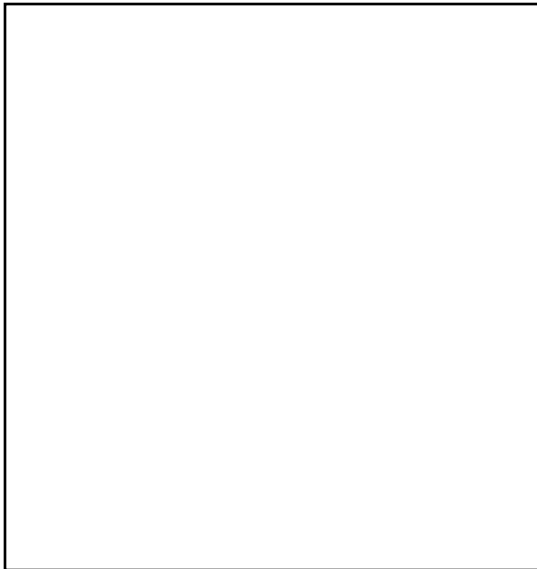
